

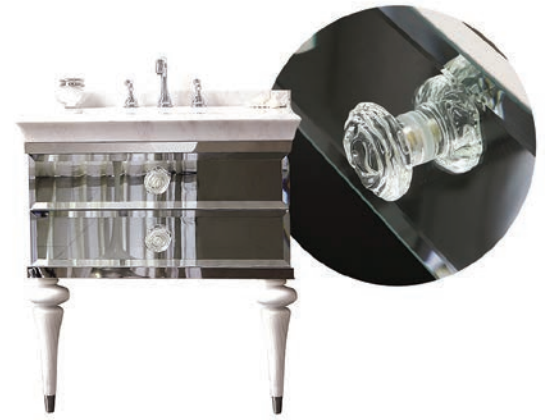


1. URBANE EATING
